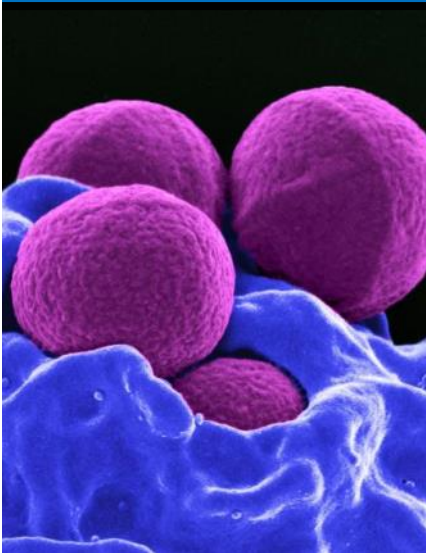




Infection Control Course Series: Module 2
