## Occasional Student Enrollment (2022-2023)

The Master of Nursing (MNurs) Programme offers various study tracks in advancing students' career in different nursing specialties. The "Emergency Nursing" study track is designed to provide registered nurses with high-quality training at master level in the area of Emergency Nursing.

Registered nurses who are keen to advance their knowledge and skills in emergency nursing are welcome to take the following course as Occasional Students.

### NURS8278 Disaster and Emergency Nursing ^

This course examines the disaster cycle including mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery, and its implications for advanced emergency nursing practice. This course also explores the range of nursing roles in disaster and humanitarian relief, and examines the systematic approach in preventing and managing complex disasters.

**Tentative Schedule: January to March 2023 (total contact hours: ~30 hours)**

**Application Deadline: November 30, 2022 (Wednesday)**

**Certificate of ATTENDANCE** and **CNE points** will be awarded to an occasional student who has attended 80% or above of lectures.

**Certificate of COMPLETION** and **CNE points** will be awarded to an occasional student who has attended 80% or above of lectures and satisfied the assessment requirements of the course for a pass grade.

**Composition fee:** HK\$10,440

- 3) A 50% discount will be offered to alumni and current students of HKU Nursing and Honorary Tutors.
