NURS8278 Disaster and Emergency Nursing

This course examines the disaster cycle including mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery and its implications for advanced emergency nursing practice. This course will also explore the range of nursing roles in disaster and humanitarian relief, and examine the systematic approach in preventing and managing complex disasters.

Certificate of ATTENDANCE and **CNE points** will be awarded to an occasional student who has attended 80% or above of lectures.

Certificate of COMPLETION and **CNE points** will be awarded to an occasional student who has attended 80% or above of lectures and satisfied the assessment requirements of the course for a pass grade.

Composition fee: HK \$10,440 for each course (Subject to the University's approval).
