NURS8270 Paediatric Cardiac Nursing

This course focuses on the latest evidence and advanced nursing practice related to congenital heart conditions in paediatric patients. The course explores advanced knowledge, clinical management, and inter-professional approach in caring paediatric patients with heart disease. Special attention will be given to current interventional and surgical management of heart defects. The course will also explore the knowledge and clinical applications of mechanical circulatory support and perfusion in paediatric patients.

NURS8261 Clinical Application of Adult Perfusion

This course focuses on the clinical applications and management of mechanical circulatory support and perfusion practice in patients with advanced cardiac problems. The course explores the assessments, and treatments in cardiac patients requiring short- and long-term mechanical circulatory supports. Emphasis is placed on the best practice and complication prevention on patients receiving extracorporeal circulatory support or intravascular circulatory supports, such as cardiopulmonary bypass heart-lung machine, Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation (ECMO), and Ventricular Assist Devices (VADs).

Cardiopulmonary Bypass Machine Workshop**

This workshop provides experiential learning and hands-on experience of heart-lung machine application, including circuit priming, operating, and trouble-shooting of common problem related to heart lung machines during open heart surgery.

ECMO Workshop**

This workshop provides experiential learning and hands-on experience on the operation Extracorporeal membrance oxygenation (ECMO), including circuit priming, operating, and trouble-shooting, and retrieval of ECMO patient in a team approach.

- Certificate of attendance and CNE points will be awarded to an occasional student who has attended 80% or above of lectures.
