An event that provides an opportunity for visitors to learn more about the undergraduate programmes we offer and our diverse student communities in HKU.

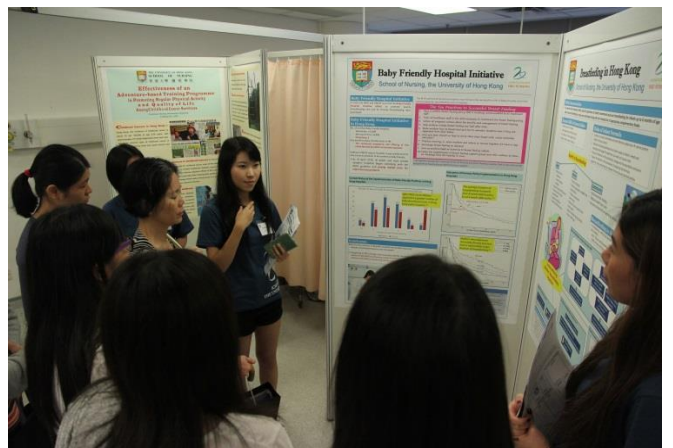


Why HKU Nursing?
