Around 200 outgoing exchange places to over 35 partner universities are offered each year

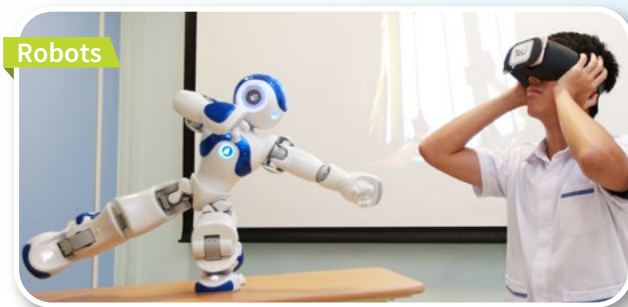


> 110 incoming exchange students from 18 partner universities in 2018/19



> CUTTING EDGE ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY & FACILITIES

VR CAVE, 360 VR, 3D graphics, VR videos and robots, etc., have been adopted to facilitate students' understanding of patient symptoms, case management and promoting concepts of artificial intelligence in shaping the health care provisions



> ENHANCEMENT OF ON-CAMPUS CLINICAL SKILLS LABORATORY

Renovated labs enhance the quality of clinical teaching and advance students' learning of clinical nursing skills



> INTER-PROFESSIONAL TEAM-BASED LEARNING

To promote inter-disciplinary learning in which students from MBBS, Pharmacy, Nursing, Chinese Medicine and Biomedical Sciences undertake training sessions to work on common clinical topics as a cross-interdisciplinary team

● ~10,000m² of operational floor area



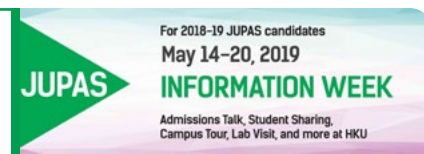
