



Professor Tracy Levett-Jones

Tracy Levett-Jones is the Professor of Nursing Education and Head of School at the University of Technology Sydney. Her research interests include: empathy, clinical reasoning, simulation and patient safety. Tracy's research is designed to inform, influence and potentially improve patient outcomes, and improve the quality of teaching and learning for healthcare students. Tracy is recognised as one of the top three nursing education researchers in Australia and was recently named by The Australian's 2019 Research magazine as the top researcher in Health & Medical Sciences in the field of Nursing. Tracy leads the Empathy Initiative research group and has over 200 publications. She has also designed a number of educational websites including the Virtual Empathy Museum and The Patient Safety for Nursing Students website. Tracy has been the recipient of multiple teaching and research awards and has been awarded over four million dollars of Category 1 funding.
